

Chino Valley Adult School students attend the school's first combined graduation ceremony that includes High School Diploma graduates, General Educational Diploma (GED) recipients, as well as those who have completed English as a Second Language (ESL), and Citizenship programs. The ceremony was held May 24 in the multi-purpose room of the Chino campus.

First combined graduation ceremony at Chino Valley Adult School is family affair

The feeling of family was overwhelming at the Chino Valley Adult School Graduation, held May 24 in the school's multi-purpose room in Chino.

The graduates – ranging in age from teens to seniors -- hugged each other, gave high-fives and thumbs up, and cheered wildly for their classmates. Half of the room was filled with cheering family members armed with cards, balloons and flowers.

It was the first graduation ceremony for the Adult School that combined the school's High School Diploma, General Educational Diploma (GED), English as a

Second Language (ESL), and Citizenship programs, according to Principal Carl Hampton.

The inaugural ceremony was planned after Chino Valley Adult School received its accreditation in 2016 from the Western Association of Schools or Colleges (WASC). Accreditation helps determine if an institution meets or exceeds minimum standards of quality, and it is often a factor in students obtaining admission to higher education.

One of the High School Diploma graduates had finished his required coursework and tests just an hour before the ceremony, Hampton said. Another – Jeff Gong – had the honor of leading the Pledge of Allegiance at the commencement ceremony. He had just become a citizen of the United States the day before.

In his speech to the graduates, Hampton emphasized the importance of getting an education, no matter the age or circumstance. He said his mother, one of 13 children, earned her high school diploma in her late 60s. The principal said his secretary Evelyn Caliz became a U.S. Citizen after immigrating to the United States, as did Chino Valley Unified School District Board of Education member James Na who was among the dignitaries at the ceremony.

Adult School teacher Jenny Gordon, who said she has the "best job on the planet," told how learning English had helped her students. One graduate said she could finally understand everything her English-speaking doctor said. Another realized that information on a personal identification card was incorrect. Two of Gordon's students – one Korean and one Spanish-speaking – sat next to each other in class and now have accents like the other because they practiced speaking to each other so much in class.

Gordon said there could be one group unhappy about the graduates who have recently become proficient in English. She said the teen children of the ESL students are not always pleased that their parents can now understand everything they say.

Principal Hampton said many of the parents who enrolled in the ESL classes have told him that their primary goal was to be able to communicate better with their children's teachers.

There are more than 20 different countries represented in the Adult School programs, school officials said.

During the ceremony, Gordon told Hampton that he "has it made" at the Adult School because the students are so dedicated and enthusiastic.
