Input on Local Control Accountability Plan sought

Board of Education gets an update Jan. 12 on the process

Chino Valley Unified School District's Board of Education held its first study session Jan. 12 on the plan that determines how the District will spend Local Control Formula Funding in the 2017/2018 school year and two years beyond to improve the academic performance of students.

Parents, staff members, and students in the District will have the opportunity this winter and spring to provide their input for the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP). **Meeting dates are posted below.**

Under LCFF, school districts statewide allocate designated state funding to improve the academic performance for all students, with an emphasis on

students who qualify for free or reduced lunches (low-income), English learners, and foster youth. This funding does not reflect the District's entire budget.

By July 1 each year, school districts are required to adopt a three-year district wide LCAP, stating goals and actions to help students improve academically.

The State has revised its LCAP document template this year with colored bars, pie graphs, and check boxes, in an attempt to improve the document's readability.

Grace Park, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum, Instruction, Innovation, and Support, met Dec. 13 with the District English Learner Advisory (DELAC) and LCAP Parent Advisory Group to kick off the community input process.

State data on student suspensions and graduation rates, expected to be released this month (January 2017), will be used in CVUSD's LCAP. Park said the district will use its own and other available measurements of student success to complete the LCAP this spring. She said districtwide student academic data will be shared with the DELAC/LCAP Parent Advisory Group when it meets next on Feb. 7.
