

Interest forms sought for

preschool readiness inclusion program

Chino Valley Unified School District is now accepting interest forms for the Preschool Readiness Educational Partnership (PREP) inclusion program for the 2016-2017 school year.

PREP Program is designed to promote success in language, pre-academics, and social development for all preschool students, including those with special needs. It is a three-hour morning or afternoon program with the option of attending two to four days a week.

Students who are identified as having special needs must first be evaluated and meet specific eligibility criteria according to federal and state requirements.

The program is staffed with an early childhood development teacher, special education teacher, and two instructional aides that work in collaboration with a speech and language pathologist, adapted physical education teacher, and an occupational therapist.

PREP will be located at E.J. Marshall Elementary School in Chino in the 2016-2017 school year. The program is currently located at the Adult School in Chino.

The District is currently exploring options to open another inclusion program in Chino Hills. Parents interested in an additional site are asked to specify that on the interest form.
