The high school junior is featured in the Yoplait Go Big campaign to highlight its large yogurt pouches. The campaign will search for teens who are doing "awesome things," according to Yoplait officials.

Brianna was named a City of Chino Young Adult Community Hero in 2015 to represent the City in the Los Angeles County Fair Community Hero program.

Brianna, the daughter of Don Lugo High Principal Kimberly Cabrera and Stephen Cabrera Sr. of Chino Hills, got involved in gymnastics for 10 years, beginning at the age of 2. She also participated for three years as an all-star competitive cheerleader for CheerForce Orange County, where she was a member of the Level 4 team Kryptonite, which won USA Nationals in March 2015.

She started a Best Buddies program chapter for Don Lugo High during the 2014-2015 school year. Best Buddies was founded in 1989 to help create friendships for students with intellectual disabilities.

She has raised a puppy for the Guide Dogs for the Blind program and served on Don Lugo's Associated Student Body leadership. She is also on the school's varsity track team, where she is pursuing her new passion of pole vaulting.

Brianna hopes to become a special education teacher, according to her mother.
