The LCAP/DELAC Parent Advisory Committee met on May 10, 2016, to review the draft Local Control Accountability Plan. At the conclusion of the review, the following questions were raised by the committee.

1. When will the plan go to the school board?

A draft of the plan will be presented to the public and the Board of Education at a public hearing on June 16, 2016. The final draft will be published on the District's web site and will be presented to the Board for approval at the regular meeting of the Board of Education on June 30, 2016.

2. What have you found helpful about our committee and have you changed anything as a result of our feedback?

From the beginning of the process and in response to stakeholder input, there have been items added to the LCAP – for instance, counselors and bilingual clerks were incorporated into the plan. Funds to facilitate the HOPE resource centers were also included, along with the addition of special education coaches. Feedback and conversations from the committee members have given us an idea of what parents feel is needed to guide our implementation. The plan is much stronger due to the conversations with all of our stakeholders.
