The overall well-being and safety of our Cal Aero Aviators is a constant priority for staff, and I would like to share a wonderful resource with you that was specifically developed with CVUSD students in mind. At the beginning of this school year, the District launched its *Student Social, Emotional, and Mental Health Support & Safety Resources* webpage.

This "One-Stop-Shop" is a comprehensive resource offering students support with harassment and bullying, social, emotional, and mental health, suicide prevention, and anonymous crime reporting.

Harassment and Bullying

The District recognizes the harmful effects of bullying on student learning and school attendance and strives to provide a safe school environment that protects students from physical and emotional harm. Accessing the Harassment and Bullying webpage, students can submit a complaint form to report bullying or harassment. The submitted form is immediately routed to the appropriate staff to begin an investigation and provide necessary support for the parties involved.

Social, Emotional, and Mental Health

In support of the District's ongoing commitment to providing its students, staff, and families a safe and healthy learning environment, students can connect with their school Multi-Tiered Systems of Support-Behavior (MTSS-B) Program Counselor, and explore various counseling supports and programs via the Social, Emotional, and Mental Health webpage.

Suicide Prevention

Each year, millions of people around the globe experience suicidal ideation. Students who are experiencing depression, social isolation, or need assistance coping with emotional distress or a suicidal crisis can reach out to trusted providers ready to assist them with their struggle. Students can access crisis hotlines that provide assistance 24/7/365, counseling services, case management resources, and upcoming suicide prevention events through the Suicide Prevention webpage.

Anonymous Reporting

If a student knows or hears of anyone who has committed a crime or is engaged in suspicious or illegal activities, they are strongly encouraged to report it anonymously through WeTip. Anonymous reports can be made 24/7/365 either by calling the WeTip hotline or visiting the WeTip website. All reports submitted through this platform are routed directly to appropriate law enforcement officials and district personnel to investigate.

Accessing the "One-Stop-Shop"

Links directing students to the "One-Stop-Shop" webpage have conveniently been placed on the homepage on the District and Cal Aero websites. In addition to posters displayed across campus, students will receive emails from the District throughout the school year to remind them of the webpage and resources available for their use.
