
## Annual Fidelity Measurements


• PBIS Tiered Fidelity Inventory (TFI): a tool that is used by school site teams to determine implementation fidelity of the PBIS Framework to best support student, staff, parent/guardian, and community need.

• Essential Standards Assessment (ESA): a determined subset of grade-specific standards within ELA and math that students must know and be able to do at the end of the year in order be prepared to enter the next grade level or course.
