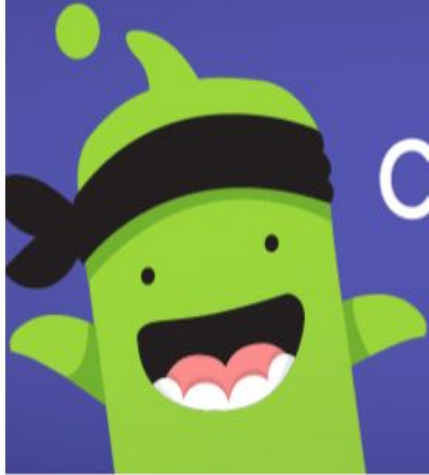




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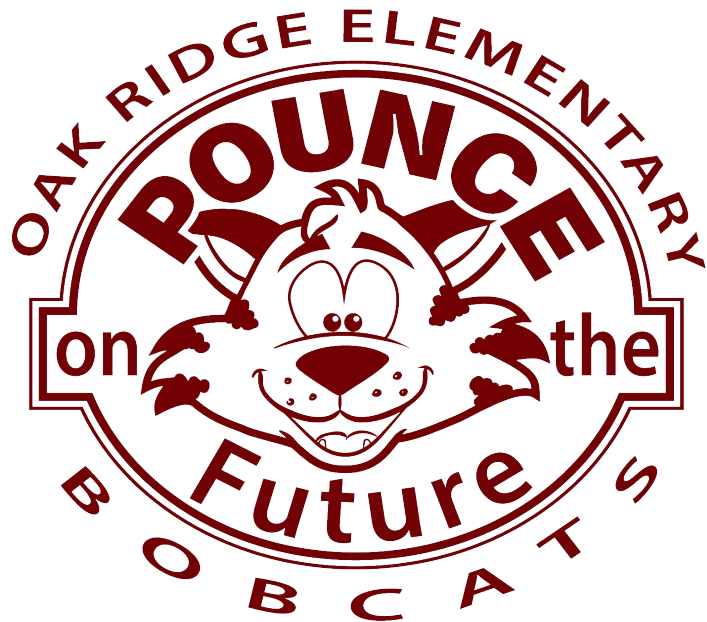

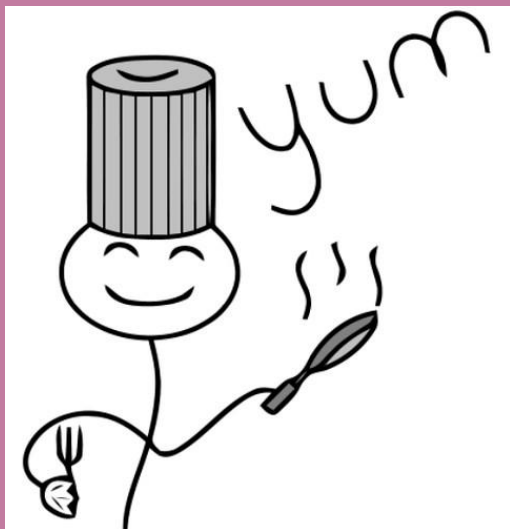
Habits of Success are provided to teachers by CVUSD to support our teaching practices. These skills are subjective.
