# Weekly Homework


- Have a place where your child can do their homework. They may need help reading directions or math story problems.Do a little bit each day.

This is a program that we use in class to play class games and quizzes using the computer. These allow for a fun way to review skills.




This is a program where kids play games that have boddle math and Language arts skills.




