Attendance Expectations

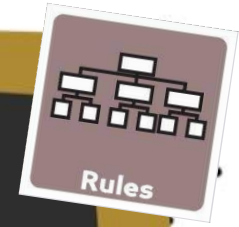
- Daily attendance will be taken by the teacher and absences must be reported and cleared online through the Country Springs website. (You cannot call the Front Office to clear an absence)

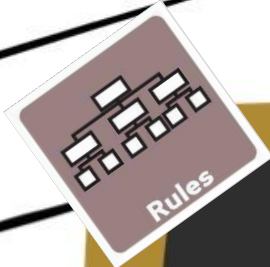

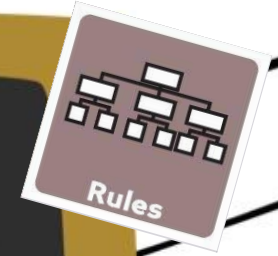

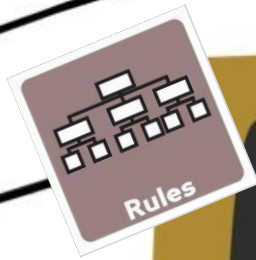
Assignment Expectations

Assessments will take place throughout the unit of study.

- Formative Assessments will be assigned throughout lessons to inform instruction.
- Summative Assessments will be administered at the end of each:
 - Unit Selection (Language Arts), Topic (Mathematics), End of Mystery Assessments (Science), and Projects (Social Studies)
- Essential Standards Assessments(ESAs), Math Benchmarks, and Writing Performance Tasks will also be administered throughout the school year to monitor student progress and will be used to further inform instruction.

- After 1 week, missing assignments will be graded as is and placed into the graded section.

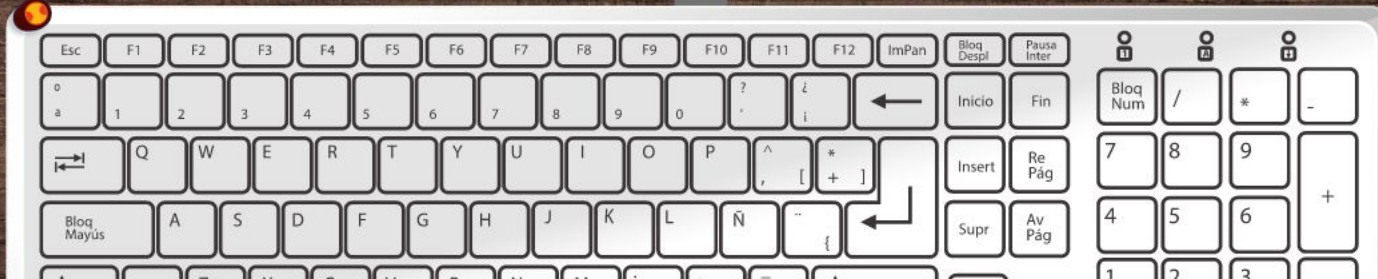

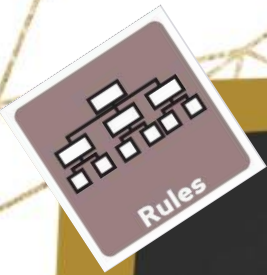


Genius Hour

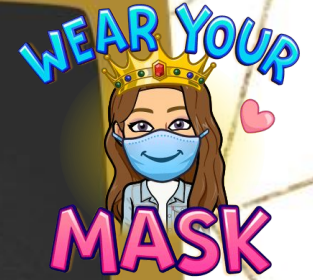


- Each trimester, every student will get the opportunity to participate in “Genius Hour”

- Go to teacher approved sites only.

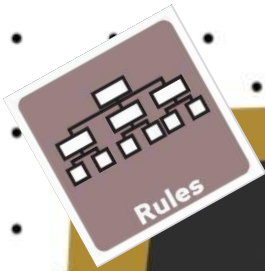
Be Responsible

Behavior Incentives

- Behavior will be documented using ClassDojo beginning Monday, August 15, 2022.
- **Students will receive positive points based on making good choices, however failure to follow All-Star Expectations will result in the loss of points.**
- Students will receive warnings prior to the loss of points, if the student fails to adjust their behavior, they will lose points.
- **Parent contact will be made if student loses more than three points for the same behavior in one class period.**
- Students may exchange points for items in our Student Store
- **Student points will also be used collectively for team/whole class rewards.**
