



Dear Parents/Guardians,

Here is a simple guide to help you decide when to keep your student home from school and when they can return based on recommendations from the American Academy of Pediatrics and the California Department of Public Health.

Fever

- Stay home if a fever is 100.4°F or higher.
- Return when fever has gone away without fever-reducing medication for a full night. ٠

Diarrhea

- Stay home if your student's stool is likely to leak or if they are unlikely to make it to the toilet in time. If the stool looks bloody or black, seek medical attention.
- Return when improving.

Vomitina

- Stay home if vomiting has occurred two or more times in 24 hours. •
- Return when vomiting has ended overnight, and your student is able to hold down liquids and • food.

If you have any questions, please contact the school health office.

Attendance

Students are expected to be at school and on time on a daily basis. Every day is an opportunity for your child to learn.

The following performance marks will be given for tardies/unexcused absences per trimester at a minimum. Other factors can contribute to a lower performance mark. Parents will receive notice from the school after 3 and 6 tardies.

<u>Tardies</u>

- \circ 1-2 tardies = 4
- \circ 3-4 tardies = 3
- \circ 5-6 tardies = 2
- 7+ = 1

Unexcused absences

- Per every 2 unexcused absences, performance mark will be lowered on Habits of Success
- Excused absence does not affect their grade


Minor Behaviors

The student meets with an administrator for counseling and development of a "plan" for correcting inappropriate behavior. Parents are contacted by administration.


