2025-2026 Magnolia JHS Colorguard Audition Process

1. Dates and Times

- a) Monday, April 28 through Friday, May 2, and run from 6:00-7:15 P.M.
- b) ALL PRACTICES WILL BE AT MAGNOLIA JHS

2. Procedure

- a) Students will participate in clinics to teach basic skills.
- b) Please attend all days. Evaluation will be continuous throughout the week.
- c) Students will be evaluated on their grade check, participation, attendance, learning ability, progress, behavior, and attitude.

3. Required Attire and Materials

- a) Students will be required to wear clothing appropriate for physical activity, such as P.E. clothes: Athletic shorts, T-Shirt, tennis or running shoes. <u>NO CUT-OFF</u>
 <u>SHORTS, SHORT SHORTS, LOW-CUT SHIRTS, BACKLESS TOPS, TUBE</u>
 TOPS, TANK TOPS, SANDALS, THONGS, OPEN TOE/HEEL SHOES
- b) Students need to turn in a self-addressed, stamped envelope for notification purposes at the actual tryout.
- c) Students will need to complete a grade check for each subject. Citizenship and Work Habits will be required as well. A copy of a report card is acceptable.

4. Notification

a) Students will be notified by mail as to the results of the tryout.

5. Team Requirements

- a) Students *must* have a GPA of at least 2.0 to perform.
- b) Students are not allowed to have any more than 1 "N" and no "U"s in Citizenship or Work Habits.
- c) Students not meeting the GPA or Cit./WH requirements will be put on probation and will have one grading period to meet the minimum requirements. Students may then be released from the team for failure to meet minimum requirements.
- d) Uniform and equipment materials are available for purchase through the Music Boosters. We have a limited number of uniforms and materials for loan. A fair share is requested that supports the budget for the program (Transportation, equipment, entrance fees, and coaches). Working shifts in the Fireworks booth help to reduce the fair share (\$15 per 4-hour shift).
- e) Students will be registered for the Tall Flag class and must be at all after school practices (2-3 per week) and performances. Failure in this area may cause the student to not be allowed to perform and/or be removed from the team.
