Class Info:

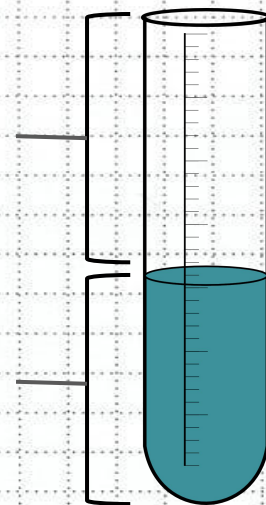

Homework & Assessments:

Any work that does not get completed in class will be assigned as homework. For additional help, you may come before/after school, or coordinate lunchtime with the teacher. In addition to homework, every few weeks we will have quizzes to check for understanding. Formal assessments will take place at least once per grading period/ trimester.



Absent & Late Work Policy:

It is the responsibility of the student to retrieve any absent work and to make-up tests. Being absent when an assignment is given, or during a lab, is not an excuse from completing it. If you are absent, you will be given one day per absence to turn in missing work. Unexcused late work will lose points each day. After the unit is done, late work will no longer be accepted. Students must make prior arrangements with me for different due dates/extensions.

Electronic Device Policy:

The only electronic device you are allowed to use in class are school issued or loaned computers. Cell phone, and other electronic device, usage will not be allowed unless specified by the teacher. You may not text, call, take pictures, record, listen to music, use apps, or visit any social media sites while in class or at school. Failure to follow this rule will result in your phone being confiscated and/or sent to the office for your parents to pick up.
