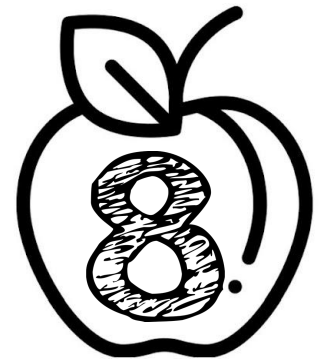

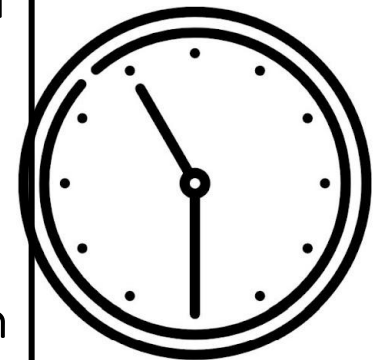

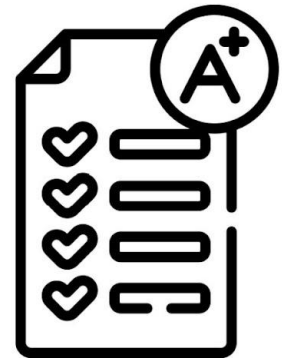
# GRADING Policy

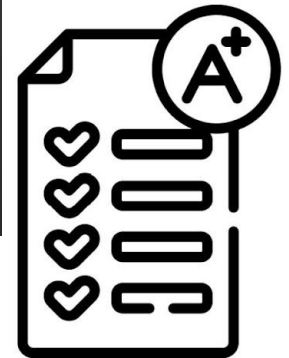

Student demonstrates understanding and performance beyond proficiency and has exceeded the standard.

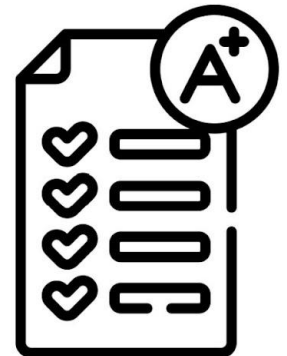

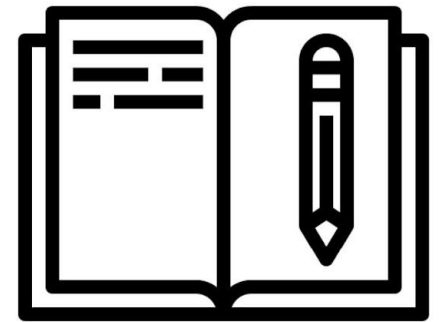

## REWARDS- House System:

After 3 Rethinking Letters for the same behavior, a demerit will be given.

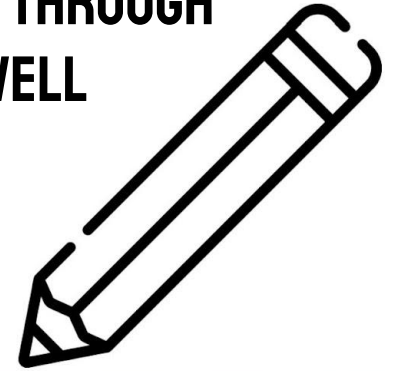

- If your child can bring in headphones, that would be great!

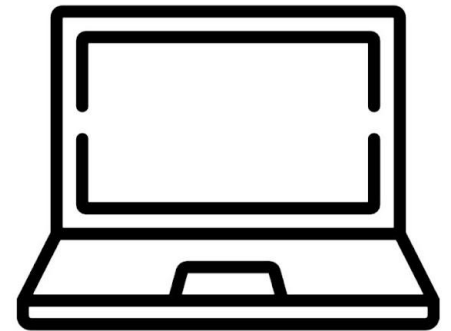
