Interactive Notebook	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Students are to maintain an Interactive NoteBook, INB, in History which will contain Classwork/Homework including notes, foldables, graphic organizers and other graphics. ❖ The purpose of the INB is to help students keep notes and work organized and available for review. ❖ INBs will be graded informally during chapter and formally at the end of chapter. 	50 points
Quizzes: Formative Assessments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Quizzes allow students to monitor how well they know the content before the Summative Assessment. ❖ There are no retakes on quizzes. ❖ Quizzes will occur weekly/bi-weekly, unless there is a test, and are based on current unit/chapter of learning. ❖ If absent for a quiz, student must take it within 5 days of their return, or it will become a ZERO in the gradebook!! ❖ Quizzes may include: Tickets Out the Door, Group Quizzes, Google Forms, and others. 	Points vary, not more than 50
Tests: Summative Assessments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Tests allow students to monitor how well they know the content without using aids. ❖ Tests will occur once a chapter/unit is completed. ❖ If absent for a test, student must take it within 5 days of their return, or it will become a ZERO in the gradebook!! ❖ Tests may include: Projects, Reports, Presentations, Google forms, and others. 	100 pts.
Absences	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ The prior assignment given is due on the first day Student returns. ❖ Each student is responsible to make-up notes and work missed due to absence. ❖ All absent work is due within 5 days of return from absence for full credit. ❖ In the case of prolonged absence, it is the student's responsibility to meet with the teacher to set up an acceptable time frame for make-up work.
