All assignments must be turned in as indicated in class (either online through Google Classroom or written on standard-sized, three-hole punched paper). Homework may be multiday, so students will need to pay attention to due dates. Please refer to the assignment set up poster in our classroom for more information on how to set up assignments.

TO EARN FULL CREDIT, HOMEWORK MUST BE ON TIME, COMPLETE, AND SHOW ALL STEPS!

<u>CLASSROOM RULES/CONSEQUENCES:</u> Our Math Department will enforce the School-Wide Classroom Behavior expectations as outlined on pages 4-9 in the student agenda.
