Results take 6-8 weeks. Parents will be notified IF their child qualified.

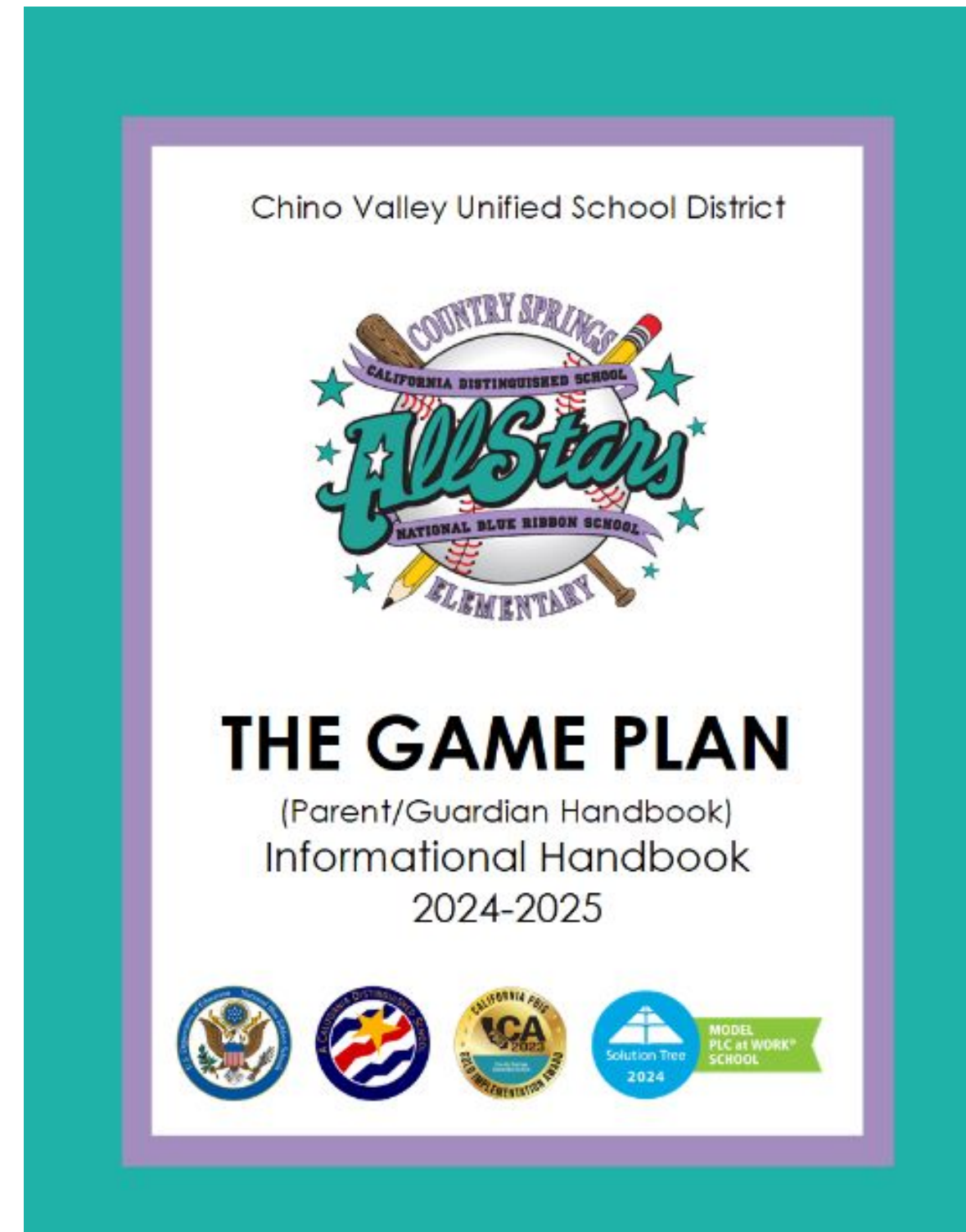




