


Consequences




ASSESSMENT

- •ELA ConnectEd assessment grades are listed on the purple half sheet. To view each online test, you will need to log in to ClassLink and ConnectEd. Use the lime green directions sheet to find them
- •Math assessment grades will be written on your child's white work page. To view each online topic test you will need to log in to ClassLink and Savvas. Use the lime green directions sheet to find them.
- Any work that has a score of 1 or 2 should be reviewed, signed, and returned.
- Your signature tells me you are aware of your child's progress, the need for improvement in that area, and have <u>reviewed the tests</u> with your child.


