Chino, CA – To assist with anxiety and stress brought on by COVID-19, Chino Valley Unified School District (CVUSD) this week launched the Wellness Assistance Line to serve CVUSD students and families with screening for assistance, referrals, and resources relating to social, emotional, and the overall well-being of students. Staffed by CVUSD counselors, individuals can call (909) 703-6130 Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. to request support.

"The social and emotional well-being of our students is a priority for us, and so important to enable students to learn at their best during Distance Learning," said Dr. Norm Enfield, Superintendent. "I am proud that our CVUSD Wellness Assistance Line is another support that we can provide to our community in order to cope with life during this pandemic."

Supports received through the Wellness Assistance Line include:

- Screenings to determine student/family needs
- Referrals and resources related to the support of the social, emotional, and overall well-being of a student
- Referrals to appropriate CVUSD departments for assistance
- Referrals to outside agencies to support student needs

The Wellness Assistance Line is not a therapeutic support line and callers should call 911 if experiencing a crisis or need immediate assistance. The Wellness Assistance Line will remain available until school campuses reopen for Blended Learning.
