

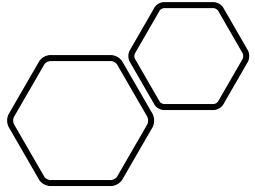

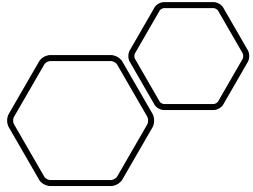


# Assignments & Grades
