## California PBIS Coalition


The California PBIS Coalition (CPC) is a collaborative organization using evidence-based, culturally relevant practices to build the capacity for all stakeholders in the implementation of PBIS as a multi-tiered system following the National PBIS Blueprints for professional development, implementation, and evaluation.

P.B.I.S. stands for Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports and is used to establish a positive school culture. Litel is currently a Tier 1, 2, and 3 PBIS school with Platinum status.


# Using PBIS to Create a Positive Learning Environment

Donations will be used to purchase large signs to display our expectations around campus, classroom matrix posters for teachers, prizes for our Leaders of the Pride, and other supplies needed for PBIS implementation on the Litel campus.



Gerald F. Litel Elementary School's PBIS journey began during the 2017- 2018 school year. Behavior expectations were set, teachers were trained, behaviors were defined, and a school-wide recognition system was established. We are a Tier 1, 2, and 3 school with Platinum implementation status. Our expectations are called the "R.O.A.R." and include Responsibility, Optimism, Accountability, and Respect. Students caught demonstrating the R.O.A.R. are rewarded with a Leader of the Pride ticket or PBIS Reward Point. Students are rewarded on a weekly basis and recognized for following our schoolwide expectations. All staff members are charged with giving students specific positive feedback in relation to how they are meeting behavior expectations. Students can receive a Leader of the Pride ticket or PBIS Reward Point from any staff member on campus.



## How can I support PBIS at home?

- Use the R.O.A.R. behavior expectations at home. "I like how you were OPTIMISTIC when that did not go your way."
- Provide opportunities at home for your child to be RESPONSIBLE and ACCOUNTABLE at home with appropriate chores and expectations.
- Give specific positive feedback when your child demonstrates a desired behavior.
- Reach out to staff members for additional support.
