





Listen and Follow Directions

Active Listening

What does it look like?



Body is calm



Brain is thinking





Ears are listening



Voice is quiet



Raise hand to talk

- Give your child multi-step directions to follow without repetition
 - Ex: Put your clothes on, and brush your teeth (say it one time only)
- Remember this is a class setting, so students need to follow directions the first time and not wait for directions to be given directly to them.
- Teach them to respond when an adult is talking to them.

Homework

Homework is sent home Monday to be returned on Friday.

Friday Folders go home on Friday and must be returned on Monday.

Homework is for review and practice.

Please check your child's work.

District policy requires homework to be no longer than 10 minutes.

Read daily with your child for at least 20 minutes.

Practice name writing, proper pencil grip, and scissor skills weekly.

CVUSD Grading Descriptors

- 4 Excelling: Students at the Excelling level of performance are consistently performing at grade level, can demonstrate independence, and can extend the grade level standards, when applicable, expected at this point of the school year.
- 3 Achieving: Students at the Achieving level of performance demonstrate an adequate understanding of and ability to apply skills needed to meet grade level standards at this point of the school year.
- 2 Progressing: Students at the Progressing level of performance are partially meeting the grade level standards expected at this point of the school year.
- I Beginning/Standard Not Met: Students at the Beginning/Standard Not Met level are not yet meeting grade level standards expected at this point of the school year.

Attendance

- Students are expected to be at school (unless it is an excused reason). Each day of school should provide an important learning experience, and if your child(ren) are not in class, they miss the learning continuity.
- Board Policy requires a parent verification of each absence within 5 school days of the student's return to school. On the sixth day, the absence becomes unverified and cannot be changed. State law requires that each absence be cleared.
- Please contact the office at (909) 393-4087 to report absences.
- Contacting the teacher about an absence is not the same as clearing the absence with the office.



Birthdays can be an exciting time for students, and we want to recognize their special day; our teachers will do their best to verbally recognize birthdays. However, in order to minimize loss of instructional time, and to follow our wellness policy, treats and goodie bags are not to be brought to school. 




