What is the TFI?

Purpose of TFI

The purpose of the PBIS Tiered Fidelity Inventory (TFI) is to provide a valid, reliable, and efficient measure of the extent to which school personnel are applying the core features of school-wide positive behavioral interventions and supports (PBIS).

What it measures

The TFI is divided into three sections:

Tier 1: Universal PBIS Features Tier 2: Targeted PBIS Features a Tier 3: Intensive PBIS Features The sections can be used separately or in combination to assess the extent to which core features are in place.

Outcomes

Criteria for scoring each item of the TFI reflect degrees of implementation: 0 = Not implemented 1 = Partially implemented 2 = Fully implemented A complete administration of the TFI produces three scale scores: Percentage of PBIS implementation for Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3. Reports are produced to guide coaching support and team action planning.
