- ✓ Continue tracking form

Intervention 4:

- ✓ Complete low level tracking form
- ✓ Send student to office during non-instructional time

Classroom Interventions

- 1. Re-teach expectations
- 2. Change seating
- 3. Think time/ time out
- 4. Student conference
- 5. Close proximity
- 6. Verbal praise
- 7. Remove distractions
- 8. Reminders, prompts, cues (verbal & nonverbal)
- 9. Provide choices
- 10. Reflection form
- 11. Apology note/journaling

<u>Teacher Managed</u> <u>Minor</u>

- Minor physical contact
- Dress code
- Out of assigned area
- Failure to follow directions
- Unkind words or attitude
- Off task behavior
- Refusal to work
- Tardiness
- Minor theft/ dishonesty
- Disruption
- Disrespect
- Inappropriate language

Office Managed Major

- Fighting/physical aggression
- Bullying/ harassment
- Drugs/alcohol
- Weapons
- Verbally abusive
- Major dishonesty
- Chronic low-level infractions
- Severe defiance of authority
- Safety concern

Intervention:

- ✓ Complete ODR form
- Note witnesses (if applicable)
- ✓ Send ODR to office; keep student in learning environment if appropriate

Administrative Response:

- ✓ Administrator investigates written report
- ✓ Student record is considered
- ✓ Administrator enters information into Aeries
- ✓ Administrative staff provides feedback to staff member



Administrator will conference with student, contact parents, and determine consequences per Ed Code
