Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Homework assignments are due for the next class meeting.</li> <li>❖ Expect to spend at least 30 minutes each night. Monday – Thursday homework worth: late work worth:</li> <li>❖ Homework when assigned on Friday will be due the following Tuesday class meeting, with late work given 5 points</li> <li>❖ Homework is considered complete when: done in pencil and the work shown.</li> <li>❖ <b><u>Late homework</u></b> will ONLY be accepted for the <b><u>current chapter of study</u></b> and receive half credit.</li> </ul>	10 points 5 or 0
Notebook	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Students are encouraged to maintain their Math 7 composition notebook and be ready for end of unit formal notebook checks.</li> <li>❖ The purpose of the notebook is to keep students notes and work organized and be a resource for their academic success in Math 7.</li> <li>❖ Notes, handouts, projects, graphic organizers, foldables, and such are to be placed into the notebook as directed by teacher.</li> <li>❖ Formal check: Notebooks will be checked at the end of each unit of study. If notebook is not turned in on test day, it will be graded at half credit-max. 20 points.</li> </ul>	40 pts.
Quizzes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Quizzes allow you to monitor how well you know the content</li> <li>❖ There are no retakes on quizzes</li> <li>❖ Unit quizzes will occur frequently, unless there is a test, and are based on homework</li> <li>❖ Spiral review quizzes taken as necessary.</li> <li>❖ If absent for a quiz, you must take it upon your return, or it will be a ZERO!!</li> </ul>	Points vary 50 points or less
Tests and Re-Tests	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Tests allow you to monitor how well you know the content without support</li> <li>❖ Notes <u>cannot</u> be used to take tests</li> <li>❖ Tests will occur once a unit is completed</li> <li>❖ If absent for a test, you must take it the day of your return, or it will be a ZERO!!</li> <li>❖ You can <b><u>retake 1</u></b> of the tests per trimester</li> <li>❖ <b><u>Retake requirements: 1)</u></b> 100% homework completion for that chapter, <b><u>2)</u></b> corrections to the original test must be made on designated form; <b><u>3)</u></b> you must get tutoring and have form signed. Tutoring form, original test, and test corrections are the ticket to taking a retake. Without these no retake can be given.</li> </ul>	100 pts.
Projects	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Retests are scheduled with the teacher and will be before school.</li> <li>❖ Projects are due on the deadline date. <b><u>Late projects</u></b> are not accepted and receive a <b><u>ZERO</u></b>, regardless of the student status on the day project is due.</li> </ul>	
Absences	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ The prior assignment given is due on the first day you return</li> <li>❖ Each student is responsible to make-up notes and work missed due to absence</li> <li>❖ All absent work is due within 2 days of return from absence for full credit</li> <li>❖ In the case of prolonged absence, it is your responsibility to meet with me to set up an acceptable time frame for make-up work</li> </ul>	N/A
