Classroom Rules and Procedures

- A monthly behavior calendar will be sent home to be viewed daily. It will stay in your child's homework folder. At the end of the month, it will need to be signed and returned. Students will earn a monthly prize for number of stickers received for the month. For example: 25–30 stickers (desk pet).
- Classroom rewards: students will fill a jar for awesome classroom behavior following our PBIS expectation. Prizes will be redeemed in class.
- If expectations aren't being followed, consequences are as followed:
 - Ist offense: discussion of expectations
 - 2nd offense: reflection sheet and discussion of expectations
 - 3rd offense: parent notification
 - 4th offense: Office referral/Administrative conference

To encourage appropriate behavior, students will receive verbal praise and encouragement, as well as rewards, bonuses, etc... (i.e. Panther Perks, stickers, special privileges, prizes...
