Homework

- Monday-Thursday and is due the next day at 7:50 A.M.
- Homework that is <u>not here or incomplete</u> when school starts will receive a Homework Ticket (Even if brought into class later in the day).
- Homework is designed to be completed within 20 30 minutes per day for the average student.
- It is usually 2 subjects of homework per night.
- Homework is to be done in <u>pencil</u> NEATLY.
- Daily reading for at least 15 minutes.
- Please check your child's homework for accuracy and completion daily.
- Homework is the student's responsibility & he/she must make sure everything is in his/her backpack & ready to go before going to bed.
- *If a student does not finish classwork assignments during class time, he/she may have to complete them at home.

Grading

- **4 Excelling** Students are **consistently** performing at grade level, can demonstrate independence, and can extend the grade level standards, when applicable, expected at this point of the school year.
- **3 Achieving** Students demonstrate an **adequate** understanding of and ability to apply skills needed to meet grade level standards expected at this point of the school year.
- **2 Progressing** Students are **partially** meeting the grade level standards expected at this point in the school year.
- 1 Beginning/Standard Not Met Students are not yet meeting the grade level standards expected at this point of the school year.

The goal is to have all 3s & 4s by the END of the school year.

Friday Folders

- Every other Friday, your child will bring home a folder of graded tests/work. The folder is due back the next school day.
- •ELA ConnectEd assessment grades are listed on the purple half sheet. To view each online test, you will need to log in to ClassLink and ConnectEd. <u>Use the lime green directions sheet to find them.</u>
- •Math assessment grades will be written on your child's white work page. To view each online topic test and see the questions, you will need to log in to ClassLink and Savvas. <u>Use the lime green</u> directions sheet to find them.
- Any work that has a score of 1 (standard not met) will be on the "sign & return" side of the folder.
- •The papers on that side will have a stamp on them. They must be signed and returned the next school day in the Friday folder.
- Your signature tells me you are aware of your child's progress, the need for improvement in that area, and have reviewed the tests ONLINE with your child.
- •Take the papers on the "keep at home" side out. I do not need them back.
- * Grade reporting is every 6 weeks






The following school supplies would be beneficial for your child to use during the school year. Please send these supplies, <u>labeled with your child's name</u>, on the first day of school.


