Grading

- Math assessment grades will be written on your child's white work page. To view each online topic test and see the questions, you will need to log in to ClassLink and Savvas. Use the lime green directions sheet to find them.
- Any work that has a score of 1 (standard not met) will be on the "sign & return" side of the folder.
- The papers on that side will have a stamp on them. They must be signed and returned the next school day in the Friday folder.
- Your signature tells me you are aware of your child's progress, the need for improvement in that area, and have reviewed the tests ONLINE with your child.
- Take the papers on the "keep at home" side out. I do not need them back.

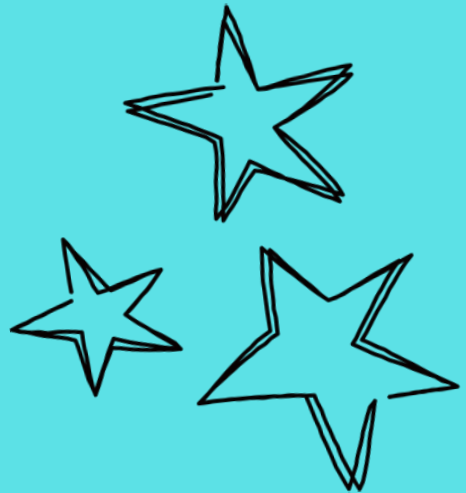

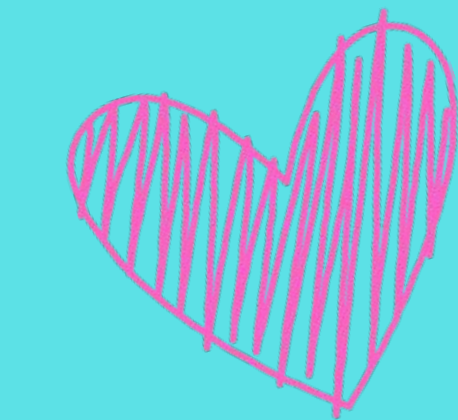
The following school supplies would be beneficial for your child to use during the school year. Please send these supplies, labeled with your child's name, on the first day of school.





