

Whole Class (Academic): Student Checklists in Candy Jar

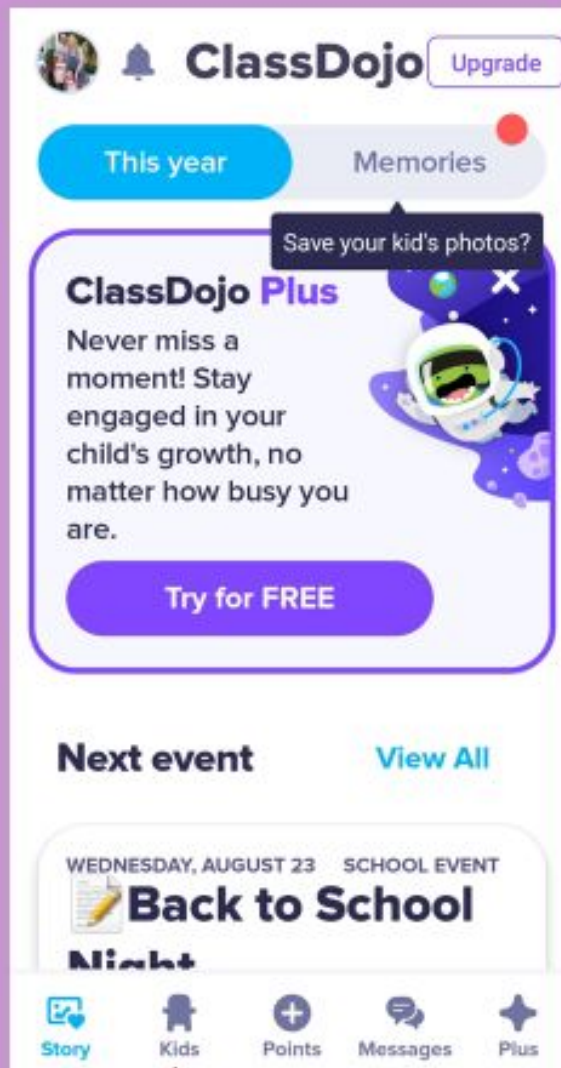
- When they fill up the candy jar they receive 15 minutes of extra recess

Whole Class (Behavior): Pom Pom Shakes

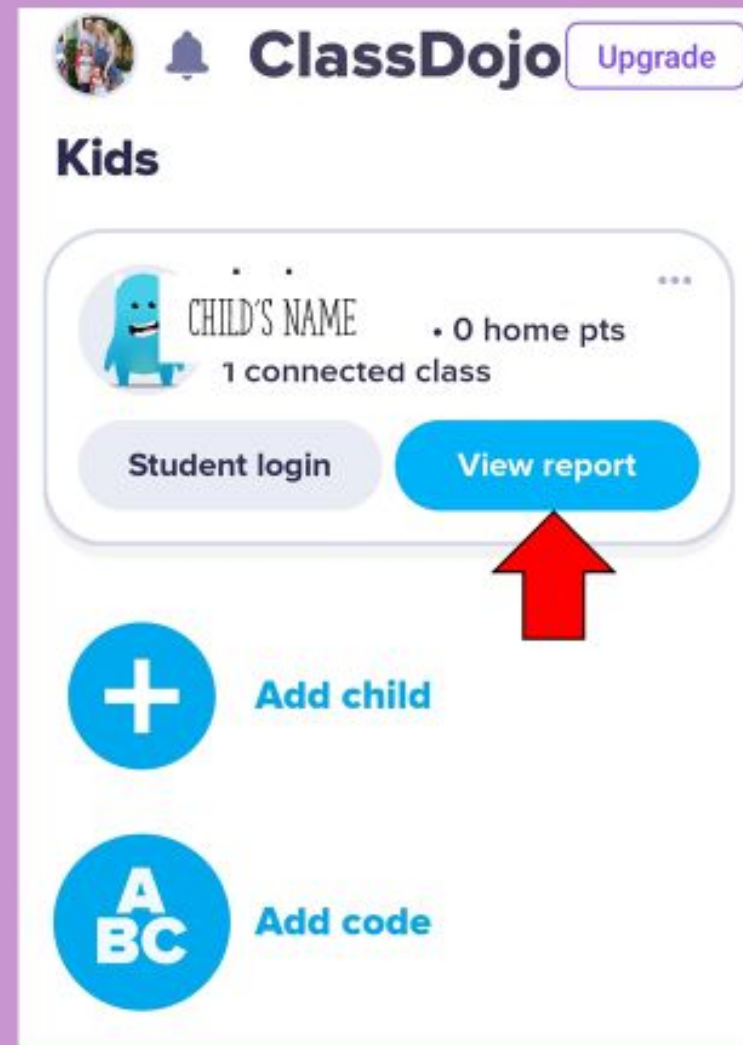
- When the acorn is filled with pom poms the students receive a special treat

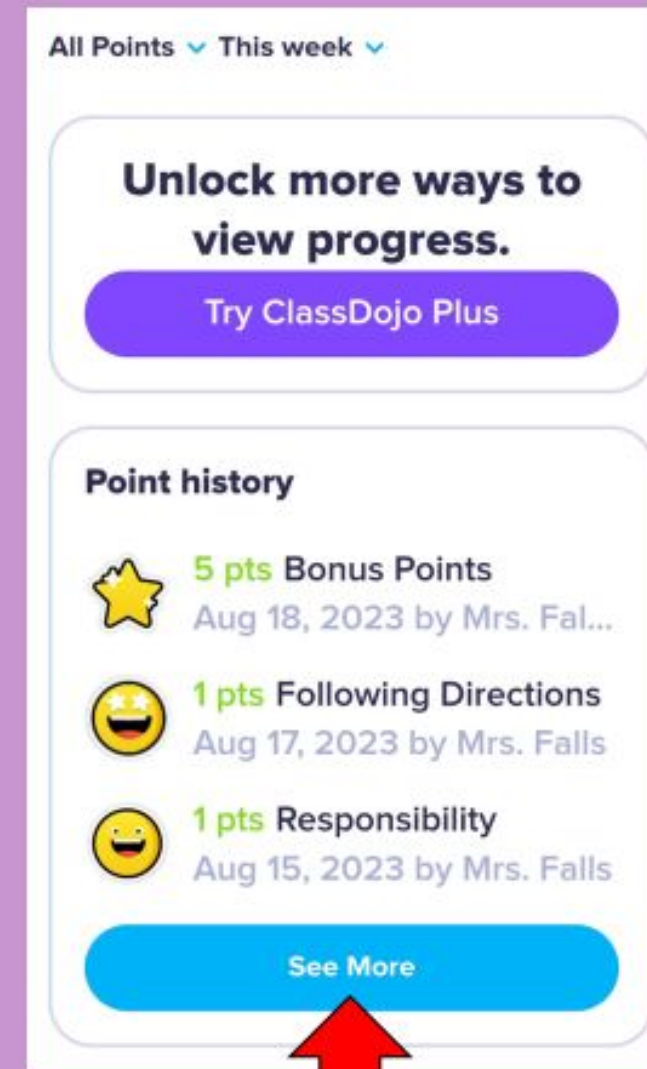

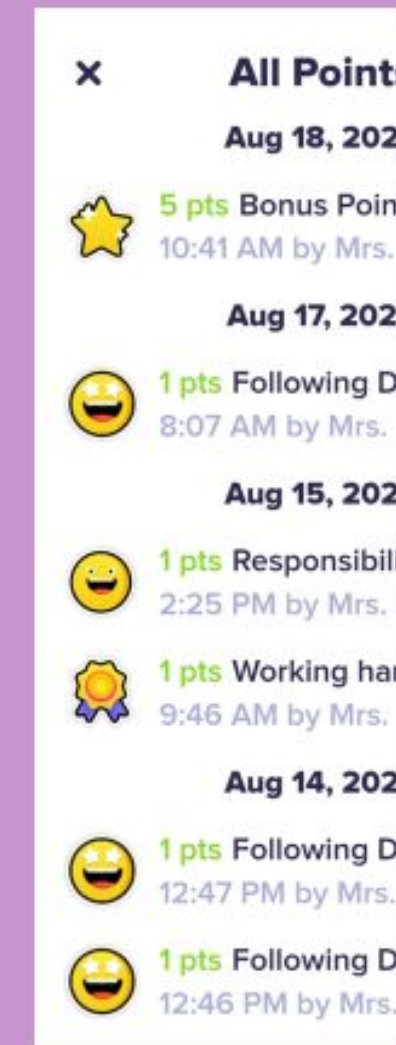

- 1 Beginning/Standard Not Met** – Students are **not yet** meeting the grade level standards expected at this point of the school year.

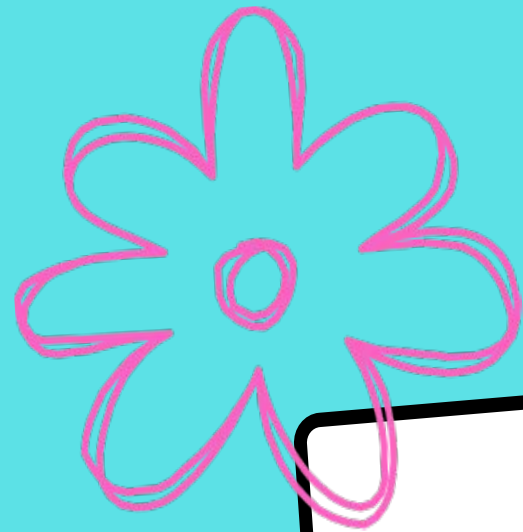
The goal is to have all 3s & 4s by the END of the school year.

- Math assessment grades will be written on your child's white work page. To view each online topic test and see the questions, you will need to log in to ClassLink and Savvas. Use the lime green directions sheet to find them.
- Any work that has a score of 1 (standard not met) will be on the "sign & return" side of the folder.
- The papers on that side will have a stamp on them. They must be signed and returned the next school day in the Friday folder.
- Your signature tells me you are aware of your child's progress, the need for improvement in that area, and have reviewed the tests ONLINE with your child.
- Take the papers on the "keep at home" side out. I do not need them back.

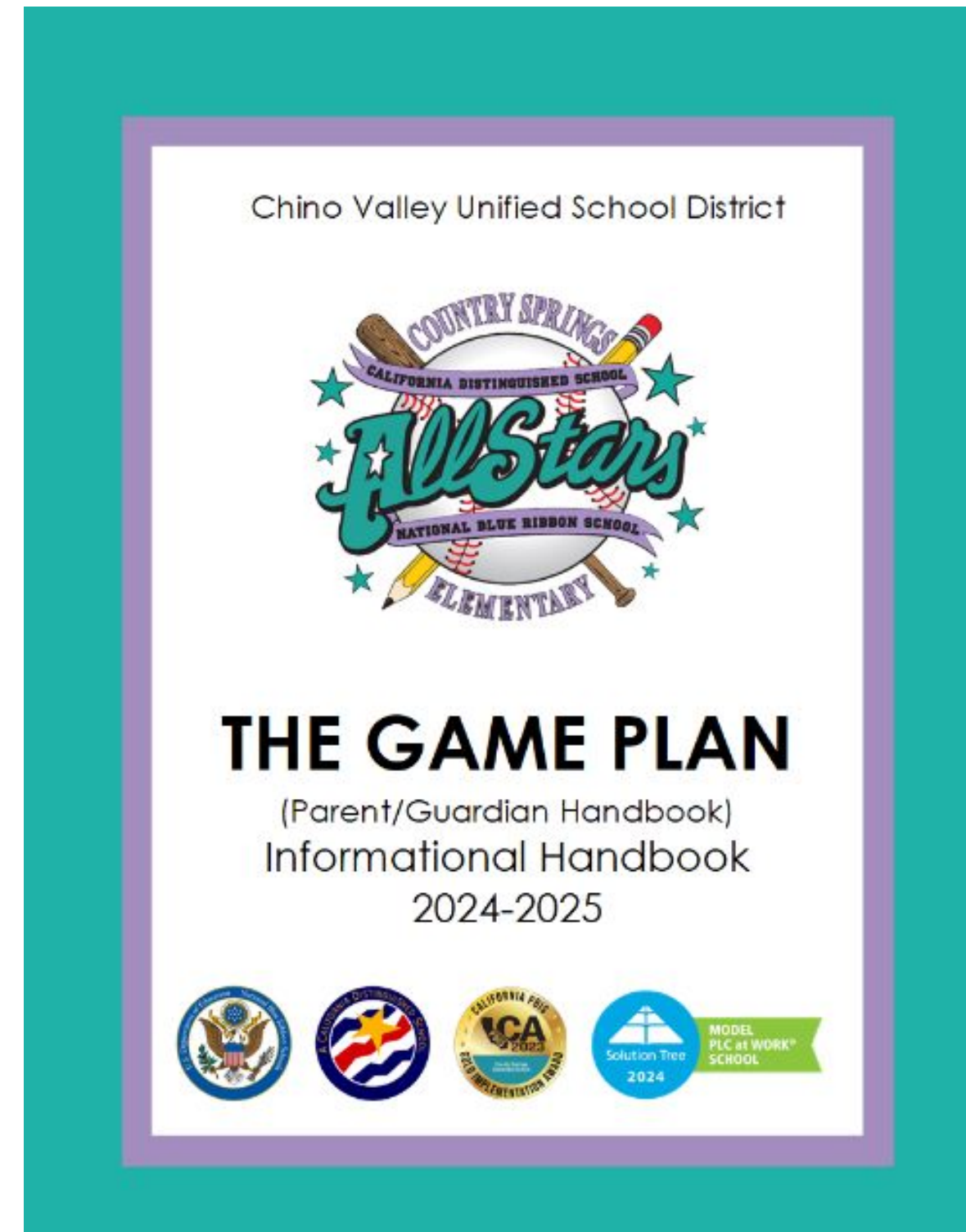

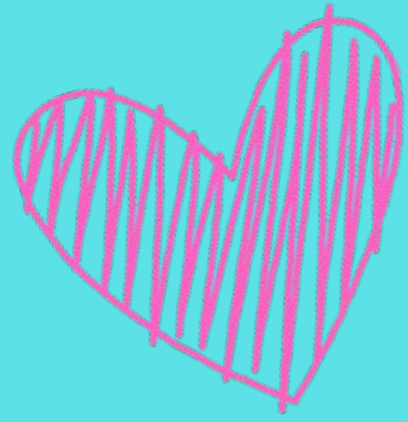
SCHOOL SUPPLY List
