
Consequences

- Level 1 Consequences Misbehavior has occured again, gets consequence




Strikes and Referrals

3 Strikes=1 Office Referral







4 Excelling – Students are consistently performing at grade level, can demonstrate independence, and can extend the grade level standards, when applicable, expected at this point of the school year.









Friday Folders

* Grade reporting is every 6 weeks








If you would like to send a treat for your child's birthday, please contact me <u>at least 2</u> days in advance.
