Read for 20 minutes	Read a non-fiction book	Read for 20 minutes

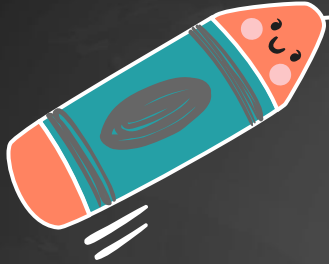

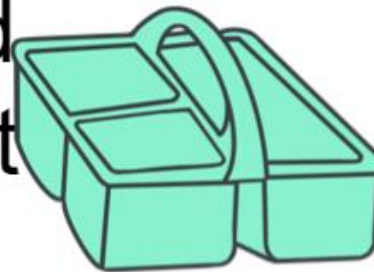
