










### Word Waves

Word waves are a series of high frequency words (sight words). These are the words first graders need to know to be successful readers. There are 10 Word Wave sets. They should be practicing each night! Every time they pass a word wave set, they will get a certificate. In addition, they will receive a special award for children who passed all 10 word waves during the trimester awards ceremony.

Jiji Math (ST Math) It is an online math platform for the students to practice their math skills in a fun way. Students get time in class when permitted to do Jiji Math. They can also do Jiji Math at home through ClassLink or directly on the Class Website. ClassLink username = your child's ID # ClassLinkpassword = their birthday month & day Jiji password = picture password

### Accelerated Reader (AR)

This is an extra reading program that we have to encourage our children to read and be excited about reading! This program will quiz your child's comprehension of the book. Students who passed Word Wave 6 is ready to begin the AR Program. When we are ready with our system to start AR, we will send out more information home.

This is an online platform that helps students receive independent practice in basic reading skills. We are still in the process of inputting in all the students for the entire school. We will let you know more information when the time comes!
