COURSE DESCRIPTION

The purpose of this class is to provide students with the opportunity to improve their communication skills in the context of everyday communication, higher education, and the workforce. Emphasis is placed on grammatical accuracy. Students will be provided with direct instruction as well as small group interaction, textbooks, reading materials, and internet resources. Listening, speaking, reading and writing will be integrated into the learning process. Exposure to computers and the internet will also enhance these learning outcomes.

LEARNING GOALS

- Expand students' ability to comprehend the mood, main ideas, and most details of what is heard in everyday communication.
- Students will speak with some spontaneity, and interpret simple materials on familiar topics.
- Students will decode the meaning of unfamiliar words and phrases, write short passages, and fill out application forms.
- EL civics topics will be addressed.
- Emphasis will be on workforce and post-secondary readiness and technology as an integral part of adult competencies

Please attend as much as you can to improve your English. Coming to class at least three times a week will help improve your English. You are expected to use English in the classroom. Speaking to new people as much as possible will help you improve your own speaking skills. Everyone in this classroom is unique and meeting new people will help you to grow as well.

To graduate from the ESL program at the end of level 5, you must have a CASAS score of 239+ and at least 100 hours of attendance. Class participation includes reading, writing, listenings, and speaking activities such as conversation practice, EL Civics lessons, and group projects.
