Chandlo, the guy you're going in the adventure with,



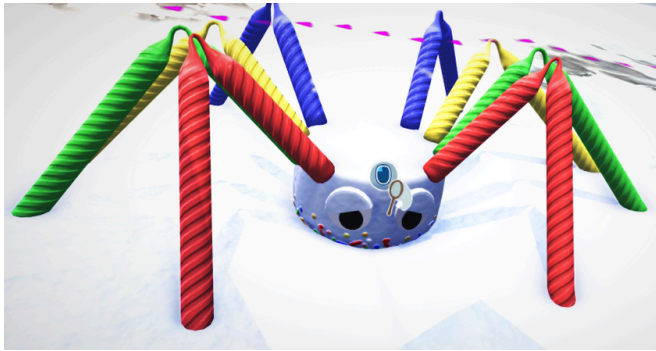
tries to attack Mama Mewon, all the babies scatter. See [this](#) video for the info on Mama Mewon and Wee Mewon.
