- **Wednesday, Sept 11 -** Completed Leadership application and Intent to Run for 6th Grade Officer position due by 2:40 PM to the Office (inside Leadership Box). Don't wait until last minute. Late applications will NOT be accepted.
- **Friday, Sept. 13 -** Acceptance letters distributed.
- **Wednesday, Sept. 18 -** Speeches due for approval by 7:50 AM to the Office (inside Leadership Box).
- **Monday, Sept. 23 -** Posters may be put up in designated areas on campus using painter's tape. (This is only for 6th graders running for an Officer position.)
- **Thursday, Sept 26 -
at 8:00 AM** Speeches for Student Leadership Officers. Assembly for grades 4-6. Parents of students running for an Officer position are welcome to sign in the office to watch. Bring a picture ID. Voting will take place in class.
- **Friday, Sept. 27 -** Announcement of 2024-25 Student Leadership Officers

Tell the person who fills out the form to place the completed form inside the envelope, seal it, sign his/her name across the sealed flap, and return to you. DO NOT WAIT LAST MINUTE TO ASK FOR YOUR RECOMMENDATIONS.
 3. **(6th Graders only)** If interested in running for an Officer position, complete the Intent to Run for Officer Form.
 4. Return the application, two recommendation forms sealed in envelopes, essay, and Intent to Run (if applicable) **(all stapled together)** by Wednesday, Sept. 11 by 2:40 PM to the Office (inside Leadership box). **Only complete and on time applications will be considered.**

- ✓ write a 1-3 minute speech. It is due on Wednesday, September 18 at 7:50 AM to the Office (inside Leadership box). Leadership advisors will review your speech and return it to you by Friday, September 20 with any needed changes.
- ✓ create up to 5 SCHOOL APPROPRIATE posters to display in designated areas on campus and use ONLY painter's tape to mount them. Posters may be put up on Monday, Sept. 23 and must be taken down by the end of the school day Friday, September 27.
- ✓ be ready to present my speech in front of a 4-6 grade assembly on Thursday, September 26.
- ✓ still be in Student Leadership if I do not get voted into an Officer position.

Campaigning:

- Student must furnish his/her own painter's tape, paper, paint, etc.
- Maximum size of any poster is 4' x 3'
- Refrain from climbing on anything to mount posters
- You are responsible for taking your posters down
- Do not use any "give aways" during the duration of the elections (tags, candy, money)
- Do not make any promises you cannot keep
