HOMEWORK/WORK HABITS: It is important that you take pride in all the work you do and that you do your very best on each assignment. All assignments must be written on standard-sized, three-hole paper. Also, you must show each step for every problem. TO EARN FULL CREDIT, HOMEWORK MUST BE ON TIME, BE COMPLETELY ATTEMPTED AND BE SHOWING ALL STEPS.

CLASSROOM RULES/CONSEQUENCES: Our Math Department will enforce the School-Wide Classroom Behavior expectations as outlined on pages 4-9 in the agenda. Remember: Always Be Safe, Be Respectful, Be Responsible!

<u>ACADEMIC HONESTY:</u> If you choose to cheat (copy) on homework, quizzes or tests, etc., you shall earn NO CREDIT, a detention, <u>and</u> lowered citizenship grade for that trimester. CW is collaborated upon, but HW is not. Multiple offenses earn further consequences.

GRADES: Grades will be weighted in the following manner (CHJHS Math Dept. Policy):

Grades are posted online in Aeries. Parents and students are encouraged to follow their progress and achievement weekly. Grades are updated weekly. Ask discrepancies should be addressed immediately. The Canyon Hills Math Department uses the Standard Grading Scale: A = 90-100%, B = 80-89%, C = 70-79%, D = 60-69%, F = 0-59%.

EXTRA HELP: Students may obtain extra help from me after school. I post my availability weekly on our side board. There are also many online tutorials by topic, such as on ixl.com and khanacademy.org. Be sure you are not just copying, but understanding.

ABSENCES: Students are responsible for the content missed when absent, starting with writing down our online agenda. Students have one day per day of absence to make up all work. It is the student's responsibility to make arrangements to make up tests or quizzes and to ask questions if anything needs clarification. Also, turn in whatever was due ON the day missed.
