II. Service/Involvement – Part A

In Section I, III-V, fill out the segment by following the directions. You must have completed at least 35 hours of community service in the past year. Describe specific, **unpaid** community service **and** include signature **and** contact information for the leader/advisor.

III. Leadership – Part A

In Section II, specify two clear leadership roles that took place over the course of <u>two semesters/seasons</u> or one year. Information under consideration is based on the previous school year and summer.

IV. Character – Parts B & C

To adequately evaluate your character, a personal response is required for <u>new applicants only</u>, plus two teacher recommendations for <u>all applicants</u>. Ask two teachers to complete your teacher recommendation letters and attach them to the application. <u>Please provide them with envelopes</u> and be sure to ask your teachers to initial the unbroken seal of the envelope used for the recommendation.
