### COURSE DESCRIPTION

INTEGRATED MATHEMATICS 3 HONORS IS THE THIRD COURSE IN A THREE-COURSE SERIES WHICH INCLUDES ALL THE COMMON CORE STATE STANDARDS FROM INTEGRATED MATHEMATICS 2 HONORS. IT BUILDS AND STRENGTHENS STUDENTS' CONCEPTUAL KNOWLEDGE OF TOOLS OF GEOMETRY, SIMILARITY THROUGH TRANSFORMATIONS, SYMMETRY, CONGRUENCE THROUGH TRANSFORMATIONS AND TRIGONOMETRY.

INTEGRATED MATHEMATICS 3 HONORS ALSO INCLUDES LINEAR RELATIONS AND FUNCTIONS, QUADRATIC FUNCTIONS, SYSTEMS OF EQUATIONS, POLYNOMIAL FUNCTIONS, INVERSE FUNCTIONS, RADICAL FUNCTIONS AND RELATIONS, EXPONENTIAL AND LOGARITHMIC FUNCTIONS, TRIGONOMETRIC FUNCTIONS AND RELATIONS, AND A CONTINUED STUDY OF STATISTICS.

**CLASSWORK:** STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND LIVE CLASSES, PARTICIPATE IN CLASS DISCUSSIONS AND ASK QUESTIONS. STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE NOTES DAILY AND ARE WORTH 5 PTS, COMPLETED. IN THE EVENT A STUDENT IS ABSENT, THE STUDENT WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR GETTING THE NOTES AND ANY WORK ASSIGNED UPON THEIR RETURN. WORK MISSED DUE TO AN UNEXCUSED ABSENCE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. ON OCCASION, STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE ASSIGNMENTS IN CLASS, *IN ADDITION TO OR IN LIEU OF* NIGHTLY HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENTS. THESE ASSIGNMENTS ARE USED AS REINFORCEMENT FOR CONCEPTS LEARNED.

**HOMEWORK:** REVIEWING DAILY NOTES AND INDEPENDENT PRACTICE COMPLEMENT DAILY CLASS LESSONS AND ARE ESSENTIAL FOR CONTENT COMPREHENSION AND RETENTION. HOMEWORK MAY BE ASSIGNED MONDAY - THURSDAY. ASSIGNMENTS ARE WORTH 5 POINTS AND CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN ONLY IF THE ASSIGNMENT IS ON TIME AND COMPLETE. A COMPLETE ASSIGNMENT IS ONE IN WHICH ALL THE EXERCISES ARE *NEATLY* COMPLETED AND NECESSARY WORK SHOWN. MAKE UP HOMEWORK DUE TO AN EXCUSED ABSENCE MUST BE TURNED IN WITHIN 3 DAYS OF RETURNING FROM THE ABSENCE. LATE WORK FOR EACH UNIT MUST BE TURNED IN BY THE UNIT EXAM. MAKE UP OR LATE WORK TURNED IN AFTER SAID DEADLINE MAY NOT BE ACCEPTED. WORK MISSED DUE TO AN UNEXCUSED ABSENCE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. PLAGIARISM (COPYING ANOTHER STUDENT'S WORK OR FROM THE INTERNET) WILL RESULT IN NO CREDIT.

**QUIZZES & EXAMS:** QUIZZES MAY BE GIVEN ANNOUNCED OR UNANNOUNCED IN EACH UNIT. TESTS WILL USUALLY BE GIVEN AT THE END OF EACH UNIT AND AT THE END OF THE SEMESTER. STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO MAKE UP QUIZZES OR TESTS DUE TO AN EXCUSED ABSENCE THE DAY THE STUDENT RETURNS FROM THE ABSENCE. THERE WILL BE NO MAKE-UP FOR TESTS OR QUIZZES MISSED AS A RESULT OF AN UNEXCUSED ABSENCE. PERFORMANCE TASKS MAY BE ASSIGNED THROUGHOUT THE SEMESTER AND WILL COUNT AS A SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT.

YOUR CHILD HAS *ALREADY* BEEN ADDED TO GOOGLE CLASSROOM. **ALL HOMEWORK/CLASSWORK WILL BE SUBMITTED IN PERSON AND COLLECTED AT THE END OF THE WEEK FOR A WEEKLY GRADE.**

**WHERE TO GET EXTRA HELP:** IT IS THE STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO SEEK HELP WHEN THEY DON'T UNDERSTAND A TOPIC. STUDENTS CAN GET HELP DIRECTLY FROM THE TEACHER TUESDAY AND THURSDAY MORNING BEFORE SCHOOL. AFTER SCHOOL TUTORING WILL BE AVAILABLE VIA OUR CAL POLY ETS PROGRAM.
