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Students will be instructed on how to study, how to become effective test takers, and acquire good study habits. They will learn techniques in taking notes, working independently, managing time, and studying. Students will develop skills in finding answers to problems, reading for meaning, and taking tests. The major emphasis of this course is to teach the student to fulfill his/her obligation for class assignments and develop effective study habits.

Major Instructional Activities

The five standard areas of the course are as follows:

Standard 1: Students will demonstrate a knowledge of time management by creating a weekly schedule of required and desired activities.

Standard 2: Students will learn “self-management” skills that allow them to monitor, reward, and direct their own study behavior.

Standard 3: Students will develop research skills.

Standard 4: Students will learn the skills necessary to be successful in lecture classes.

Standard 5: Students will understand test taking as consisting of two phases, preparing for the test and taking the test.
