

Course Overview:

Integrated Math I is the first course of a three-course sequence including Integrated I, Integrated II, and Integrated III. This course satisfies the California Common Core Standards for Integrated Math I and is intended for all ninth graders. Integrated Math I builds and strengthens students' conceptual knowledge of functions, linear functions, equations, inequalities, sequences, basic exponential functions, systems of linear equations, systems of linear inequalities, one variable descriptive statistics, correlation, and residuals, analyzing categorical data, mathematical modeling, and both coordinate and transformational geometries.

MATERIALS, Tools

1. A single subject SPIRAL notebook for notes & classwork
2. Loose line or graph paper
3. Pencils/erasers, Black or blue Pens, highlighters
4. A Ruler

Daily routine

- Arrive on time, silence your phone & put it in your backpack or phone pouch by the whiteboard
- Copy notes or collaborate with a partner to complete classwork in notebook
- Have me sign your work as proof of completion.

Classwork/Homework

- There is no Homework.
- Classwork is assigned daily except on quiz/test days.
- Classwork must be completed entirely during the period in the notebook and receive my initial.
- All assignments must include title, date, and student's name & seat#.
- All assignments must include directions, questions, and clear and legible solutions in a vertical format.
- Final answers must be boxed and justified by solution
- **Graphs** must be plotted accurately on graph papers

Assignments Will be graded for **completeness**, **adherence** to the required **format**, and their **accuracy**.

Late classwork:

- **Incomplete** classwork (**at least 70%** attempted & got stamped) may be finished as homework for up to **70% credit**.

Classwork format and expectations:

- Notes and classwork must be done in a 8.5x11 single subject lined/graphed spiral notebook or a single subject binder
- All assignments must be written legibly using a black/blue pen or a pencil only.
- Each new note or classwork must start on a new page.
- Each assignment must include important information such as title, note/classwork number, name, date, and period.
- Graphs must be plotted on graph papers and stapled in the notebook.
- Notebooks will be collected / graded on the assessment days.
- Notebooks grades are based on their **completeness** and **adherence** to the required **format**.
- Classwork/note format has been explained in class and an example is posted on the white board.

TESTS AND QUIZZES

- A weekly/ biweekly quiz and or a chapter test at the end of each chapter/unit
- A comprehensive final exam at the end of each semester. The Final test will count as 2-chapter tests.

Note:

Notebooks are checked on quiz days (often on Fridays)

HOW TO CHECK YOUR GRADE

- Classwork will be updated on **Aeries regularly**.
- Assessments will be updated after all quizzes / tests are graded.

ABSENT Policy

- You will have up to as many days as you were absent to turn in missed assignments. (For instance, if you were absent on a Monday, you would have to turn in absent work no later than Wednesday)
- You need to make up any missing Quiz/Test on the day you return to class regardless of the number of days you were absent.
- If you don't make-up a missing test, the absent code will be replaced with a "F"
- You may not postpone any quiz/test if you were absent a day or days prior to a test or quiz.
- You are responsible for copying all missing notes from a classmate and ask me for any classwork you missed.
- If you miss class to attend a rally or be in the office, you are expected to come by and receive your classwork for that day.
- If you plan to be out of town for any reason, request for assignments in advance before leaving and submit your work on the day you return to class. Also, make arrangement to make-up any missing quiz/test.

ADEMIC HONESTY

Cheating of ANY kind will result in a score of ZERO on the assignments, tests, or quizzes. If a student is found with another student's assignments (or picture of it), both students will receive a ZERO. Talking of any kind, having unauthorized materials (including personal electronic devices), or "wandering eyes" are considered cheating. (see student handbook)

CLASSROOM RULES

In addition to the rules outlined in the Student Handbook, students are also expected to follow the rules below:

1. Come to class on time and bring the daily needed material
2. Sit at assigned seat and keep all unnecessary objects and personal electronics OFF and PUT AWAY
3. Collaborate with partner to complete classwork & have me stamp it as the proof of completion.
4. Stay on task during period and refrain from inappropriate language and any distraction (eating, drinking, socializing, Etc.)
5. Be responsible for your own learning. Collaborate with peers or ask questions
6. Respect the teacher, classroom, and other classmates

DISCIPLINE POLICY

A variety of corrective measures will be used in order to maintain a successful learning environment. If a student chooses to behave poorly by not following rules or directions, their behavior will result in one or more of the following:

1. Verbal/Non-verbal warning and/or speaking with teacher after class
2. Parent/Guardian contact via email and a possible behavior contract
3. Parent/Guardian contact via email and detention*
4. Referral to office
5. Suspension from class

***Detentions** must be served within a week of receiving it. If the detention is not served within the allotted time, it will be doubled. If the detention is still not served, a referral to the office will be given.
