

## **Ayala Traffic Pattern**

All vehicles dropping off (7:00 am-7:40 am) and picking up (2:00 pm-3:00 pm) will enter at Bulldog Blvd, and travel around campus via the fire lane. Students may exit or enter vehicles at any point around campus. Drop off and pick up should be done in the left lane and thru traffic should use the right lane. Please be very careful as students may be exiting from the right side of vehicles.

Parents will not be allowed to enter the horseshoe lane before school.

No entry will be allowed at the north driveway. This will be an exit only.

## **Back-to-School Drop off and Parking Reminders**

Ayala High School traffic will be impacted by the ongoing construction underway at Peyton Drive and Eucalyptus Avenue. Parents are encouraged to get an early start and use several tools that provide information about the project. The City website, <a href="https://www.chinohills.org/PeytonConstruction">www.chinohills.org/PeytonConstruction</a>, includes a link to two webcams that provide a live view of the project area 24/7.

In addition to dropping students off at the campus (see the <u>campus flow traffic map</u>), parents of Ayala students can take advantage of a student drop-off area at the Chino Hills Community Center on 14250 Peyton Drive. Motorists using this option will be required to enter the parking lot at Bulldog Way, and turn left to the southern parking lot before dropping off students. These motorists must exit south on Peyton Drive, no exceptions. Safety will be enhanced if motorists follow this one-way traffic flow during drop-off and pick-up periods. Student drop off is NOT allowed anywhere on Peyton Drive.

Ayala students need to be aware that parking at the Government Center is reserved for Government Center visitors only. The City will begin the school year with an educational effort, followed by an enforcement effort, to ensure that students do not park at the Government Center lot.

AYALA HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT DROP-OFF ZONE AT NEW CHINO HILLS COMMUNITY CENTER LAUNCHES MAY 12<sup>TH</sup>

Starting on Monday, May 12<sup>th</sup>, the City of Chino Hills will allow Ayala High School student drop-off at the Chino Hills Community Center parking lot for the remainder of the school year. Motorists may enter the parking lot at Bulldog Way, turn left to the southern parking lot, and exit south on Peyton Drive. Safety will be enhanced if motorists follow this one-way traffic flow during drop-off and pick-up periods. City officials will evaluate the effectiveness of the use of this parking lot as a student drop-off zone.
