1st PRIORITY APPLICATION PERIOD
July 1, 2020 – January 15, 2021

Students are encouraged to apply during the above **1st Priority Application Period**. Accepted students will receive priority consideration for campus housing and scholarships. The **2nd Priority Application Period** is January 16, 2021 – April 1, 2021. Applications received after the priority periods will be reviewed on an ongoing basis as space permits.
