Brian Hamilton Memorial	Senior student who has been accepted to a four-year college, preferably an athlete who is active in their church.
Butterfield Memorial	Senior student(s) who have excelled in sports and in academics, and plan to attend a four-year college.
Cadet Lapeyrade Memorial**	Senior planning to attend a community college or trade school to major in vocational arts studies, such as welding, carpentry, auto mechanics or other trade. Minimum GPA of 2.5
Cindy Abeyta Memorial	Senior student who has shown great improvement academically over the past four years and is planning to attend a four-year college. Student should have also been involved in extracurricular activities.
Hazel Weller Memorial**	Must have completed four years at Chino High School and plan to attend a state college or university. Academics are the primary criteria for selection, but financial need will also be considered.
Michael Ricottone Memorial	Senior student planning to attend a community college or trade school to major in the Auto industry or who has taken ROP classes.
Paul Wade Memorial	Senior student planning to major in Agriculture in college.
Roy Seidel Memorial	Senior student planning to attend a community college or trade school to major in Industrial Arts/Vocational Arts.
Zeke Cortez Memorial	Must have completed a minimum of 4 semesters at Chino HS, be of Hispanic descent & plan to major in education or business. Financial need & academic success are considered.
Veterans of Foreign Wars	CHS Senior student who will be continuing their education and has improved academically. Prefer a student whose family has served or is serving in the military; however, it is not mandatory. Financial need will be given priority. A \$500 scholarship will be awarded.
