FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION?

CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION, OR CTE, IS A PROGRAM OF STUDY THAT INVOLVES A MULTIYEAR SEQUENCE OF COURSES THAT INTEGRATES CORE ACADEMIC KNOWLEDGE WITH TECHNICAL AND OCCUPATIONAL KNOWLEDGE TO PROVIDE STUDENTS WITH A PATHWAY TO POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION AND CAREERS.

WHAT IS A CTE PATHWAY?

A CTE PATHWAY IS A SEQUENCE OF TWO OR MORE CTE COURSES WITHIN A STUDENT'S AREA OF CAREER INTEREST. PATHWAYS ARE DESIGNED TO CONNECT HIGH SCHOOL CLASSES TO COLLEGE, INDUSTRY CERTIFICATIONS, AND/OR A CAREER.

STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE A FULL PATHWAY OF AT LEAST 300 HOURS IN ORDER TO RECEIVE PATHWAY CREDITS. PATHWAYS MAY CONSIST OF INTRODUCTORY, CONCENTRATOR, AND CAPSTONE COURSES.

<u>INTRODUCTORY COURSE</u> - A CTE BEGINNING LEVEL COURSE THAT CONTAINS INTRODUCTORY CONCEPTS REQUIRED TO BUILD FOUNDATIONAL AND GENERAL KNOWLEDGE.

<u>CONCENTRATOR COURSE</u> - A CTE COURSE BEYOND THE INTRODUCTORY LEVEL THAT IS INTENDED TO PROVIDE MORE IN-DEPTH INSTRUCTION AND EXPLORATION OF A SPECIFIC INDUSTRY SECTOR.

<u>CAPSTONE COURSE</u> - THE FINAL COURSE IN A PLANNED SEQUENCE OF COURSES THAT PROVIDES A RIGOROUS AND INTENSIVE CULMINATION OF A COURSE OF STUDY.

WHAT IS COMMUNITY CLASSROOM?

COMMUNITY CLASSROOM IS UNPAID TRAINING AT A JOB SITE. TRAINING USUALLY TAKES PLACE DURING CLASS HOURS. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE STUDENT TO SECURE TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM THE TRAINING SITE. STUDENT MUST BE AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD.

IS THERE A FEE FOR ROP CLASSES?

As of July 1, 2015, BVROP is no longer direct funded by the State of California. BVROP is now funded by our member districts, as a service provider supporting their local control accountability plans (LCAPs).

OUR AGREEMENT WITH OUR MEMBER DISTRICTS FOR THESE FUNDS PROVIDES THAT ROP/CTE SERVICES ARE RESERVED FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING HIGH SCHOOLS, CONTINUATION HIGH SCHOOLS, AND ALTERNATIVE HIGH SCHOOLS BELONGING TO CHAFFEY JUHSD, CHINO VALLEY USD, CLAREMONT USD, AND UPLAND USD.

ALL OTHER, GRADE 9-12, STUDENTS OR SCHOOL ENTITIES MAY ACCESS BVROP SERVICES BY CONTACTING DR. ROSE BOMENTRE, ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT OF EDUCATIONAL SERVICES (ROSE_BOMENTRE@BVROP.ORG) TO OBTAIN THE FEE-FOR-SERVICE COSTS AND REGISTRATION PROTOCOL.

CAN I ENROLL IN MORE THAN ONE COURSE?

YES, YOU CAN ENROLL IN MULTIPLE COURSES AS LONG AS THE CLASS SCHEDULES DO NOT CONFLICT.

WILL I RECEIVE A CERTIFICATE?

YES. YOU MUST EARN A "C" OR BETTER AT COMPLETION OF YOUR ROP CLASS TO RECEIVE A CERTIFICATE.

CAN I RECEIVE COLLEGE CREDIT?

YES! MANY CTE COURSES AT BVROP HAVE AGREEMENTS IN PLACE TO OFFER STUDENTS COLLEGE CREDIT THROUGH VARIOUS COMMUNITY COLLEGES. STUDENTS EARN COLLEGE CREDIT BY COMPLETING SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN EACH CLASS. THE NUMBER OF COLLEGE UNITS VARY BY CLASS. PLEASE SEE PAGE 8, COLLEGE CREDITS INFORMATION PAGE, IN THIS SCHEDULE OR CONTACT YOUR HOME HIGH SCHOOL CAREER TECHNICIAN FOR MORE DETAILED INFORMATION.

IS THERE AN AGE REQUIREMENT?

SOME CLASSES HAVE AN AGE REQUIREMENT. COURSES WHICH HAVE REQUIREMENTS AND/OR PREREQUISITES CAN BE FOUND UNDER EACH COURSE TITLE.

CAN MY STUDENT ATTEND CLASS AT A DIFFERENT DISTRICT OR CAMPUS?

YES, IF THE COURSE IS AVAILABLE AFTER SCHOOL, IN THE EVENING, OR ON THE WEEKENDS. IF THE DESIRED COURSE IS OFFERED DURING REGULAR SCHOOL HOURS, STUDENT MUST RECEIVE PRIOR APPROVAL FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE CAMPUS WHERE THE CLASS IS BEING OFFERED. 



Career Technical Education (CTE) provides students of all ages with the academic and technical skills, knowledge and training necessary to succeed in future careers and to become lifelong learners. In CA, there are 15 recognized Industry Sectors and 58 Career Pathways.





STATE MEASURE: **College/Career Readiness**

Career Technical Education courses support high schools with preparing students for success after graduation in the following ways:

PREPARED: Measure shows how well high school graduates are prepared for success.

Students must meet at least one of the criteria below:

OR

College Credit Courses:

Two semesters of college coursework with a grade of Cor better in academic/CTE subjects where college credits

are awarded*.

Career Technical Education (CTE) Pathway:

Pathway completion with a grade of C- or better in the capstone course

University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) a-g requirements:

Complete a-g course requirements with a grade of C- or better

One semester of college coursework with a grade of C- or better in academic/ CTE subjects where college credits are awarded for

Students enrolled in our CTE courses eligible for college credits will receive support with claiming their college transcript(s) during scheduled times.

Claiming Articulated College Credits

Courses identified as articulated are eligible to earn college credits once the course is successfully passed and you meet <u>all requirements</u> outlined in the articulation agreement. You will only receive college credit if you (1) pass the BVROP class earning the minimum grade required by the college articulation agreement and (2) meet all additional requirements, such as passing an exam, as described by the articulation agreement. Articulation agreement requirements are described in the class syllabus, given by the instructor on the first day of class. In order to get college credit for articulation, students must apply to the community college that is awarding the credit. See steps below:

Make sure you have the following information readily available:

(Reminder: Always protect your identity, keep information in safe place or memorize)

- Legal Name (First Middle and Last)
- Complete Address (including zip code)
- Date of Birth
- Social Security Number (SSN) optional

Personal Email Address that is checked frequently

(not HS email address as you will lose access after graduation).

College Application Process You must apply to the college in order to establish a student record and receive a student ID number. It is required to receive articulated credit.

The college application is a multi step process:

Step 1: Create OpenCCC account early in the semester
Go to CCCapply.org select college where course is articulated
User Name: Password:
Step 2: Apply to College.
 You will automatically be redirected back to the college application, click start "New Application." Answer "YES" to the supplemental question asking if you are a Career Transitions student. *not all colleges ask this question After you submit your application, write down your confirmation number.
Confirmation Number
*A community college ID number will be e-mailed to the personal e-mail address you provided within 72 hours.
Step 3: When you receive your college ID number, write it down College ID #
Step 4: Now that you have your college ID number, notify your instructor. Your instructor will give you further instructions about how to apply for articulated credit depending on the college.
