Notebook	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Students are encouraged to maintain their Accelerated Math 7 notebook and be ready for end of unit formal notebook checks. ❖ The purpose of the notebook is to keep students notes and work organized and be a resource for their academic success in Accelerated Math 7. ❖ Notes, handouts, graphic organizers, foldables, and such are to be placed into the notebook as directed by teacher. ❖ Formal check: Notebooks will be checked at the end of each unit of study. If notebook is not turned in on due day, it will be graded at half credit-max. 20 points. 	40 pts.
Quizzes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Quizzes allow you to monitor how well you know the content. ❖ There are no retakes on quizzes. ❖ Unit quizzes will occur frequently, unless there is a test, and are based on homework. ❖ Spiral review quizzes taken as necessary. ❖ If absent for a quiz, you must take it within 2 days of your return, or it will be a ZERO!! 	Points vary. 50 points or less
Tests and Re-Tests	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Tests allow you to monitor how well you know the content without support. ❖ Notes <u>cannot</u> be used to take tests. ❖ Tests will occur once a unit is completed. ❖ If absent for a test, you must take it within 2 days of your return, or it will be a ZERO!! ❖ You can retake 1 of the tests per trimester. ❖ Retake requirements: 1) 100% homework completion for that chapter, 2) corrections to the original test must be made on designated form; 3) you must attend tutoring and have form signed. Tutoring form, original test, and test corrections are the ticket to taking a retake. Without these no retake can be given. ❖ Retests are scheduled with teacher and will be before or after school. 	100 pts.
Projects	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Projects are due on the deadline date. Late projects are not accepted and receive a ZERO, regardless of the student status on the day project is due. 	
Absences	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ The prior assignment given is due on the first day you return. ❖ Each student is responsible to make-up notes and work missed due to absence. ❖ All absent work is due within 2 days of return from absence for full credit. ❖ In the case of prolonged absence, it is your responsibility to meet with me to set up an acceptable time frame for make-up work 	N/A
