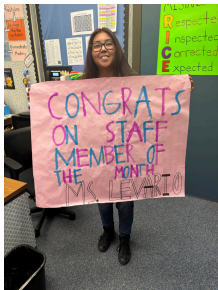

MJHS held our annual Halloween Costume contest in the month of October. There were great costumes! We also had our Dia De Los Muertos Lunch with the parents of our students.



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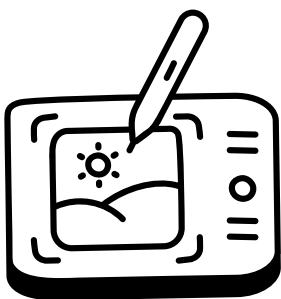
