Loma Linda Ronald McDonald House Fact Sheet

Mission Statement

The Loma Linda Ronald McDonald House is a home away from home for families of children with illnesses or injuries receiving medical treatment at Loma Linda University Children's Hospital and other nearby medical facilities.

Ronald McDonald House Charities Background – The First Ronald McDonald House opened in 1974 with the renovation of an older home near Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. Since then, more than 356 houses in 42 countries and regions, (179 in the U.S.) have been built around the world as well as 208 Ronald McDonald House Family rooms in 23 countries, 123 in the U.S. and 49 care mobiles in 9 countries, 38 in the U.S.

Ronald McDonald House Charities of Southern California – Operates six houses and a camp in the Southern California Chapter, Los Angeles, Bakersfield, Pasadena, Loma Linda, Orange County, Long Beach and Camp Ronald McDonald for Good Times.

All Houses and Camp operate under the one 501 (C) 3 and raise money independently for their own entity.

- The Loma Linda Ronald McDonald House is located at 11365 Anderson Street in Loma Linda on the southeast corner of Barton Road and Anderson Street and is within walking distance to Loma Linda University Children's Hospital.
- The Loma Linda Ronald McDonald House opened on September 11, 1996.
- The Loma Linda Ronald McDonald House can accommodate 24 families nightly.
- More than 1,200 families served in 2015, checking in over 3,785 people.
- In 2015, there were 746 families referred to hotels, because of the House being at 100% occupancy.
- Room requests are sent from the social workers at the hospital; it is based on diagnosis and distance 20 miles away. However, shorter distances are considered on a case by case basis and based on room availability.
- A fee of \$10.00-\$20.00 per night is charged to stay at the House. However, no family is ever turned away due to inability to pay.
- The average length of stay for families is seven days.
- Funds to operate the House come from contributions through individual gifts, special events, corporate donations, foundation grants, memorial and honorary gifts.
- Support has been received through the efforts of McDonald's Operators
 Association of Southern California and McDonald's Corporation, as well as the
 local and national chapters of Ronald McDonald House Charities.
- Volunteers donate nearly 10,000 hours of service annually.
