Graduation Cap/Gown and Announcements

You should have already secured your cap and gown package, graduation announcements, and special commemorative products for graduation. You can also order online at www.jostens.com or call (800) 567-8367. Late order forms can be found on Ayala's home page under the Students tab, then Senior Information, then Cap & Gown. You can purchase the cap & gown package which includes everything you will need for graduation or you can borrow a used gown, cap, tassel and medallion from Jostens but you must return everything before you leave the graduation venue to meet your family. If you fail to return the entire package at the end of the ceremony before you leave the venue, you will be charged for the items. You cannot return it at another time. If you have a gown from a sibling or friend, you must bring it in to Ms. Ives for approval.

GRADUATION CEREMONY TICKETS

Additional Information

It is very important that you read each of the newsletters that are given to you. Some of the information will be duplicated and some information will be new. - Attend all Graduation Practices and Meetings
- Pay all your fines on time—All fines need to be paid by May 11th so that you can pick up your graduation tickets.
- Meet all deadlines for graduation tickets, senior breakfast, and senior day trip.

Counseling/Testing Information

- SENIOR GRADUATON STATUS will be posted in Aeries in January 2023. Seniors/Parents will be notified via email and text and are encouraged to log in to their Aeries account and review the information. Check with the student's Counselor if alternative education options are needed.
- CREDIT RECOVERY Deadline to enroll for Credit Recovery session 3 is January 20, 2023. Credit Recovery session 3 is Jan. 31 March 2. Deadline to register for Credit Recovery session 4 (last session) is February 10, 2023. Credit Recovery session 4 is March 14 April 20. Please see your counselor ASAP to register.
- FAFSA deadline is March 2, 2023
- CAL GRANT GPAs were all submitted electronically on September 30, 2022. Any Senior who entered Ayala after September 30, 2022, should contact the counseling office regarding our Cal Grant GPA submission.
