East Coast Trip 2020 Behavior Contract

I, _____, will be taking a trip from March 21 – 26, 2020. This will be an excellent learning experience that I can reflect on for many years to come. To guarantee an enjoyable trip for students and adults, I will need to follow some simple rules of behavior to be eligible to go on the trip and remain with the group. **Any student possessing any alcohol, drugs, tobacco, or any related paraphernalia or involved in illegal acts such as larceny, vandalism, or any unforeseen infraction of the law will immediately be dismissed without any repayment, and at additional parental expense.**

I, _____, will commit to the following on the East Coast Trip 2020:

1. Following all school / district rules for behavior.
2. Being responsible for all personal belongings at all times.
3. Responding on time to pre-arranged meetings and bus departures.
4. Following all directions given by the group leaders or adult supervisors.
5. Never leaving the hotel/room after lights out.
6. Never allowing anyone else in the hotel room.
7. Using technology and Social Media wisely.
8. Being mature enough to handle money transactions without adult supervision.
9. Preventing any problems for security.
10. Not causing any disturbance in public places including planes, waiting rooms, hotel rooms / lobbies / corridors, restaurants, etc.
11. Not possessing any medications unless proper paperwork has been recorded with CVUSD nurse and Trip Leader.
12. Not possessing any alcohol, drugs, tobacco, or any related paraphernalia (matches, lighters, etc.).
13. Never involving myself in a situation which might be construed as illegal.
14. Not purchasing something that is dangerous or illegal.

If I don't follow these simple rules and regulations while on the trip, the following consequences will occur:

1st Violation: One to three-hour sanction with constant supervision to ensure good behavior. Phone call home to parents.

2nd Violation: All day sanction with constant supervision to ensure good behavior. Phone call home to parents.

3rd Violation or Extreme Situations: Student will be sent home on the next available flight after notifying the parents of departure time and added expenses.
