Chino Valley Unified School District does not require community service hours for graduation.

GRADING SYSTEM

The following numerical equivalents are used to determine GPA for use in reporting to all outside agencies. In order to receive credit for a class, a student must receive minimum grade of D- in that class. All grades are converted to a four-point scale:

A or A - = 4.0, B or B - = 3.0,

C or C - = 2.0, D or D - = 1.0, F = 0

Weighted classes such as AP receive an additional point:

A = 5, B = 4, C = 3

Due to California legislation - AB104, some students elected to receive a Pass/No Pass in place of a letter grade for the 2020-2021 school year.

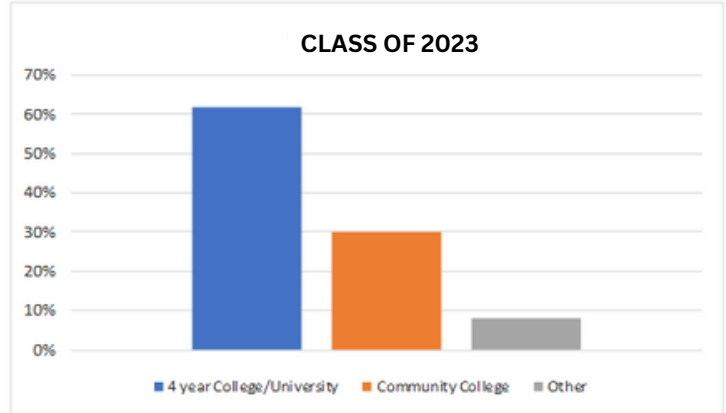
